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Process for Applying for a Firearm Licence

(Current Jan-B--2026)

Process is to be done online, paper applications only for minor permit

❖ To complete your online application you will need in advance the following the scanned documents:

- Firearms Safety Training Certificate.
- Supporting documents for your Genuine Reason and Special Need.
- Identity documents (100 point identification).
- Documents supporting claim to primary producer or pensioner fee exemption (if applicable)

Also the following:

- E-Mail address and your mobile number (important)
- A 'MyServiceNSW' Account linked to NSW Police Force
- A credit card for payment of the NSW Police licence, (if applicable)

The course costs **\$110 Adults, \$45 juniors.**

❖ Supporting documents for your Genuine Reason and/or Special Need

- "Sport/Target Shooting" – Target Shooting activities on a range, (Club proof is required)
- "Recreational Hunting/Vermin Control" – Hunting on rural land, permission to shoot from the owner/occupier or authorised Government agency (Letter of Authority)
- "Primary Production" - No cost for licence but has restrictions on use. (proof required)
- "Firearms Collection"- Firearms in collection **cannot be fired** and must be for historic, thematic, financial or commemorative value. (Club paperwork is required)

There are many different types of **Animal Welfare** reasons. (Please review the NSW police website fact sheets)

SSAA NSW can only support 'A'/'B' Category Licence for Target Shooting, Hunting and 'G' Collector.

❖ Once you have completed the application online it will be adjudicated and if successful you will receive a letter of approval and photo advice from the NSW Firearms Registry which requires you to attend to your local Service NSW within 90 days, failure to complete this will forfeit the application. After this final step you will then receive your licence via the post/mail.
